

Information note for students applying for Student Exchange Programs

Every AUCA student have a chance to apply for exchange programs and gain a priceless and unforgettable experience living and studying abroad. Being exchange students is highly appreciated and welcomed by Psychology department. However, students must be aware about the possible issues with not being able to take on time required courses with prerequisites. Thus exchange students must be aware that they will not be free of fulfilling the program requirements and not being able to graduate according to a 4-year study plan. Being on an academic exchange is not an excuse for violating the curriculum.

As a student applying for an Exchange Program I _____
fully understand that the curricular of the host university and AUCA's may be incompatible and offered courses may not be matched. I am therefor aware that I may not be fully able to fulfill the required curriculum while on exchange. I understand that in my hosting university courses which are pre-requisite to required courses in AUCA may not be available and that this will result in my inability to enroll in these required courses upon my return to AUCA. It may mean I will not be able to graduate according to a 4-year study plan at the Psychology Program in AUCA. I was informed about such possible consequence and I take full responsibility for these repercussions and agree to a possible necessity to extend the duration of my study to more than 4 years.
