TRANSFER POLICY International and Business Law Program

- 1. Students from other AUCA departments may transfer to the International and Business Law (IBL) Department subject to following conditions:
 - a. The student must hold good academic standing, holding a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7.
 - b. The student completed at least first semester of studies with 30 cr load.
 - c. The student passed Philosophy of Law course with a minimum "B" grade.
- 2. To be considered for transfer, students are required to submit application and transcript to the Head of the Program for approval.
- 3. Students meeting the minimum academic requirements are not automatically guaranteed acceptance into the IBL Department. The number of available positions will vary from year to year as determined by the Department. The number of positions is also subject to the quota of the license provided by the Ministry of Education of the Kyrgyz Republic. Students transferring into IBL program during the second or third year of study are required to follow the checklist order and sequence of required courses to be taken during the studies.
