

Minor in Business Administration

1. The Minor in Business Administration is designed for AUCA students to enhance their marketability and build resume. Students completing the BA minor will gain a solid foundation in four primary business disciplines: management, marketing, finance and financial accounting.
2. To apply for minor, students must have a minimum of GPA 3.0 or higher in their major.
3. To earn the Minor degree in Business Administration, students must earn a total of **42 credits**.
4. Students must obtain the approval of the Chair of their major program and the Chair of SEBA before declaring a minor by submitting Minor declaration application.
5. Other requirements:
 - a. Students must earn a grade of “C-” or higher in each required minor course
 - b. Students must pass Minor exam at the end of studies, which is comprised of 4 disciplines:
 - i. Introduction to Business and management
 - ii. Introduction to Marketing
 - iii. Introduction to Finance
 - iv. Financial Accounting I
 Passing grade for minor exam is “D-” or above.
