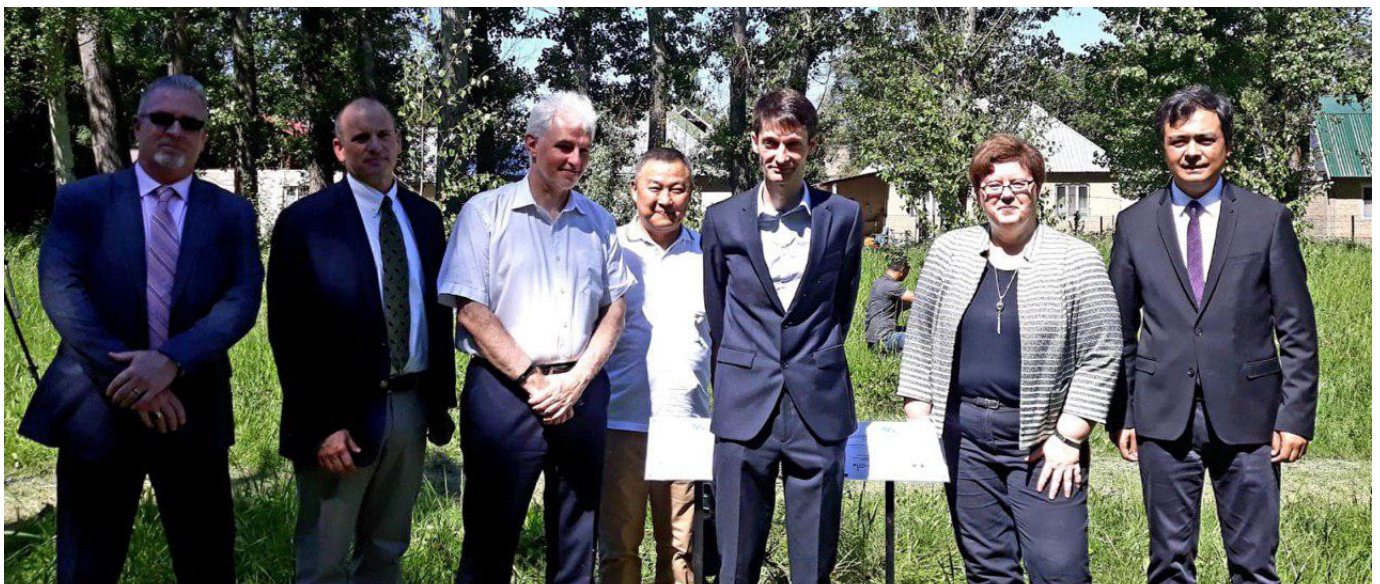


Presentation of the Ecopark project on the occasion of "Climate Diplomacy Week"
