A) ENTRANCE EXAM:

1. Taking NGA Program Entrance Exam, which is an English language test,
2. Taking and using scores taken at the AUCA Entrance Exam (ELPT, Essay and Math)
3. Submitting official TOEFL or IELTS scores.

NOTE: The NGA and AUCA exams are offered in Kyrgyzstan. Applicants applying while being abroad will be able to take the NGA Entrance Exam upon their arrival in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. Meanwhile, NGA Application form and required documents should be submitted to the NGA program first. **Those with an English language test scores (AUCA Exam, official TOEFL/IELTS) are exempted from taking the NGA Program's Entrance Exam and must only sit for an interview after submitting the NGA Application form and required documents.**

B) INTERVIEW:

All NGA applicants SHOULD get interviewed by the NGA Search Committee members after submitting their application packages. The interview will be scheduled in advance and held either in person or online via Skype/Zoom.
