Minor

Specification

- **F (Fail)**
- A student who receives an “F” must repeat the course.
- A student who receives an “F” in the same course for a second time is to be dismissed from the University
- **W (Withdrawal)**
- This grade indicate that the student has decided not to continue with the course.
- The student must repeat the course if it is a required course
- This grade can be given by a professor only within the period established by the Registrar Office
- Does not impact the GPA
- But you lose credits

Specification

- **I (incomplete)**
- This grade indicates that a student has completed most, but not all, of the course requirements, due to extenuating circumstances, such as an illness or a family emergency.
- An Incomplete grade contract is to be signed by instructor and student
- If student fails to complete the required work by the deadline (6th week of the subsequent semester) s/he will be automatically receive an “F” grade
- **AU (audit)**
- Audits are useful for students who want to explore courses outside their majors or when students find courses that are of particular interest but would require extraordinary effort to take for a grade along with other required courses in the major
- Permission of Advisor and Instructor is needed
- **P (pass)**
- Students receive credit for a passing grade, but no quality points

Internships

- An internship is a pre-professional, educational experience, where students have an opportunity to enhance their theoretical knowledge by applying it in practice.
- The main goal of an internship is for students to gain practical skills related to their specializations in a real-world work setting.
- In its entirety, internship is an effective way for students to prepare for their future careers.
